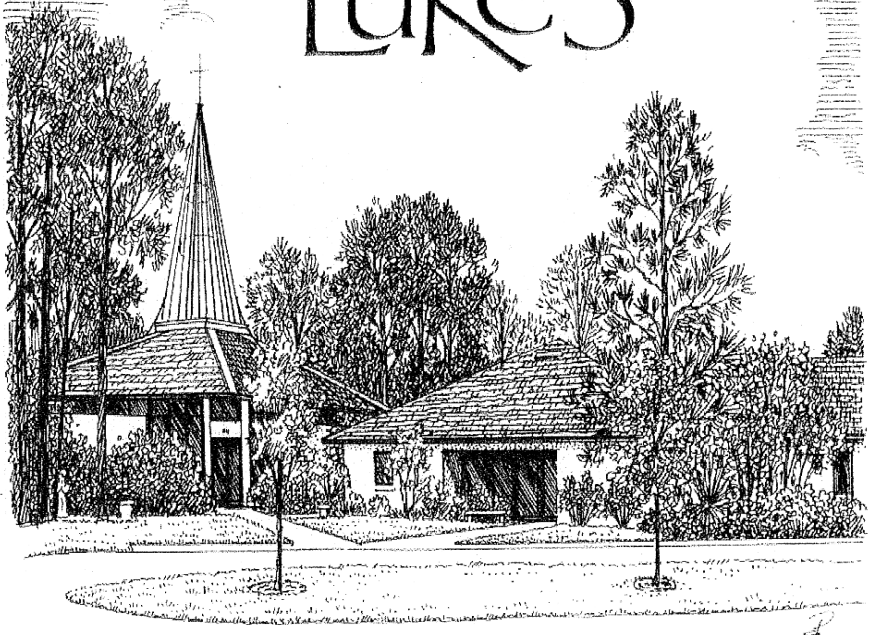

## THE HOLY GOSPEL

Matthew 5:1-12

**Celebrant:** The Holy Gospel of our Lord, Jesus Christ,  
according to Matthew.

*People:* *Glory to you, Lord Christ.*

When Jesus saw the crowds, he went up the mountain; and after he sat down, his disciples came to him. Then he began to speak, and taught them, saying:

"Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

"Blessed are those who mourn, for they will be comforted.

"Blessed are the meek, for they will inherit the earth.

"Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness,  
for they will be filled.

"Blessed are the merciful, for they will receive mercy.

"Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God.

"Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called children of God.

"Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness' sake, for theirs is  
the kingdom of heaven.

"Blessed are you when people revile you and persecute you and utter all  
kinds of evil against you falsely on my account. Rejoice and be glad, for  
your reward is great in heaven, for in the same way they persecuted the  
prophets who were before you."

**Celebrant:** The Gospel of the Lord.

*People:* *Praise to you, Lord Christ.*

- Reader: Father, we pray for your holy Catholic Church;  
*People:* *That we all may be one.*
- Reader: Grant that every member of the Church may truly and humbly serve you;  
*People:* *That your Name may be glorified by all people.*
- Reader: We pray for Justin, the Archbishop of Canterbury; Michael, our Presiding Bishop; Peter, our Bishop; Fritz and Faye, our Archdeacons; John, our Canon to the Ordinary and Licia, the Co-adjutor Canon to the Ordinary; Kwasi, the Bishop's Deputy for Special Ministries; pray for the Church of the Province of West Africa;\* for this gathering; and for all ministers and people.  
*People:* *That they may be faithful ministers of your Word and Sacraments.*
- Reader: We pray for all who govern and hold authority in the nations of the world; especially Donald, our president, and Ron, our governor.  
*People:* *That there may be justice and peace on the earth.*
- Reader: Give us grace to do your will in all that we undertake;  
*People:* *That our works may find favor in your sight.*
- Reader: Have compassion on those who suffer from any grief or trouble; especially...  
*People:* *That they may be delivered from their distress.*
- Reader: Give to the departed eternal rest; especially...  
*People:* *Let light perpetual shine upon them.*
- Reader: We praise you for your saints who have entered into joy;  
*People:* *May we also come to share in your heavenly kingdom.*
- Reader: Let us pray for our own needs and those of others.  
*Silence*
- Celebrant: Almighty God, by your Holy Spirit you have made us one with your saints in heaven and on earth: Grant that in our earthly pilgrimage we may always be supported by this fellowship of love and prayer, and know ourselves to be surrounded by their witness to your power and mercy. We ask this for the sake of Jesus Christ, in whom all our intercessions are acceptable through the Spirit, and who lives and reigns for ever and ever.\*\*  
*People:* *Amen.*
